Dear Mr. Kolmacic,

Be advised that I represent Ohioans for Concealed Carry.

It has come to my client's attention that the City of Campbell has recently enacted an emergency ordinance making the sale of firearms within in city limits illegal. After correspondence with my client, the City Council decided to amend the ordinance to prohibit the "retail/commercial" sale of firearms alone. To my knowledge this amendment was tabled and no decision has been made to date. It is clear under Ohio Revised Code §9.68 that the actions and proposed actions of the City of Campbell are illegal.

The purpose of this letter is to demand that the City immediately correct the ordinance to comply with the Ohio Revised Code. My client is prepared to pursue any and all legal remedies available against the City if no action is taken. Please be advised that R.C. §9.68(B) provides for financial relief to my client in the event a lawsuit becomes necessary.
